

Peace Corps Test Sites Announced

Peace Corps volunteer tests will be given for the last time this year at 8:30 Saturday morning. The non-competitive tests are used to place Peace Corps volunteers.

Testing centers for area residents are located in Los Angeles and Long Beach. The Long Beach tests will be given in Room 2, Post Office Building, Third Street and Long Beach Boulevard. The Los Angeles Post Office Building is located at 312 N. Spring St. The test will be given in Room 518.

Applicants who have not completed Peace Corps questionnaires will be asked to do so after the testing sessions. Tests will last about one and a half hour. Volunteers with a knowledge of French or Spanish will be asked to take a one hour language placement test.

MORE THAN 6,000 new opportunities in the Peace Corps are now available in Africa, Asia, and Latin America. No knowledge of a foreign language is required.

Assignments are available for persons with skills such as nursing, carpentry, and engineering. Liberal arts college graduates, and others with no special skills, have been very useful as teachers and community development workers.

Applicants must be citizens of the United States, at least 18 years of age. Married couples are eligible if both qualify and have no dependents under 18 years of age.

Minister Speaks of The Bible

"What Baptists believe about the Bible" will be the subject for the Rev. Charles T. Hughes Jr. at the 11 a.m. worship services at the Western Avenue Baptist Church Sunday.

"There is a great difference between the Bible and other books," the Rev. Mr. Hughes said when he announced his topic.

"Authors may pray for God's help and guidance, and God does help and guide," he said. "However, the most saintly of authors would hardly dare claim for his books that they are books of God."

THE PASTOR said the Bible is God's word in a sense that no other book in the world can match. Abraham Lincoln, in a tribute to the Bible, said, "I believe the Bible is the best gift God has ever given to man—all the good from the Saviour of the world is communicated to us through this book."

Pastor Hughes will speak on "The Father's Love and Christ's Return" at the 7 p.m. services Sunday.

"It is one thing to be a Christian and it is another thing to walk with him in close fellowship and obedience," he will say. He will speak of the second coming of Jesus Christ as "the greatest incentive to Christian living."
