

State Insurance Code Regulates Rates on Autos

The rates and rate-making processes of all insurance companies writing automobile insurance in California must comply with the provisions of the McBride-Grunsky Insurance Regulatory Act of 1947, which consists of Sections 1850 through 1860.3 of the California Insurance Code. Under this Act, the records and methods of the rating bureaus, and the rating methods and records of individual companies setting rates independently of the rating bureaus, are subject to examination and review by the examiners of the Department of Insurance, State of California, 1407 Market St., San Francisco 93103.

This activity goes on continuously and when any particular rate is not substantiated by statistics and other information, the insurance companies or rating bureaus are requested by the State Insurance Commissioner to make modifications. Such requests have been honored uniformly since the enactment of the 1947 Statute. Incidentally, the present Commissioner is Stafford R. Grady, The Chief Assistant Insurance Commissioner is Joseph D. Thomas who has been with the Department of Insurance for many years. Any complaints about the regulation of insurance companies, rates, or other relevant subjects, should be sent to either of these gentlemen at the San Francisco office.

AUTOMOBILE insurers in California are not making excessive profits. Some companies in the past 10 years have made some modest profits in automobile insurance, but on the whole the insurance companies have suffered a net loss on automobile insurance running into several million dollars in California.

The automobile insurance business in California is highly competitive and there is no method by agreement or otherwise whereby the insurance companies may maintain a high level of rates over all classifications of people, or over any particular classification of individuals.

One gentleman wrote me that he believed that persons of advanced years with good driving records are good risks and that the insurance companies could make large profits by selling automobile insurance to this class of people at standard rates, that is, at rates which disregard age. I asked the Insurance Commissioner about this and he said that the gentleman who wrote to me was mistaken, that if it were possible to make large profits by selling automobile insurance to people of advanced years with good driving records, at standard rates, then the conditions

of competition are such that dozens of companies would be in the market offering such coverage immediately.

AN INSURANCE agent is a person authorized by and on behalf of an insurer (insurance company) to transact insurance business. In California, "insurance agent" most often refers to one who transacts fire and casualty insurance; however, other types of agents are frequently included under this phrase. The insurance agent is working for an insurance company as a salesman for that company.

In California, an insurance broker is a person who acts for compensation on behalf of another person and transacts insurance, except life insurance, but not on behalf of an insurer. In other words, he is working for his client (customer) primarily. This is in contrast with an agent who works primarily for the company.

In California, an insurance solicitor is a natural person (i.e., not a corporation or partnership) employed by an insurance agent or broker to aid in transacting insurance other than life insurance.

IN CALIFORNIA, the reason that life insurance is normally not included in the above definitions is that those who sell life insurance are separately classified and defined in the Insurance Code.

Air Force Offers New Law Agenda

In an effort to meet the rising demand for legal officers, the Air Force, through the Judge Advocate General Commissioning Program, is now offering direct commissions to lawyers. The commissions are in the grade of first lieutenant through colonel, depending on age, education, experience and ability.

All applicants for commissions must be graduates of an accredited law school and be members of a Federal Court or of the highest court of a state. Applicants also must be citizens of the United States and meet the established physical requirements. In some instances waivers for certain physical defects are granted.

Senior students of an accredited law school may apply up to 30 days prior to graduation, but documentary evidence of graduation and admission to the bar must be submitted before final acceptance can be made.

Accepted applicants attend a four week basic legal officer orientation course at Lackland Air Force Base, Tex., prior to a regular duty assignment. The minimum tour of active duty is three years.
