Manager Of Gold's Appointed

Richard Markson has been named manager of the new store being opened in the Gold's Furniture and Appliances.

Markson said that construction of the new building at 4310 Artesia Blvd. at Hawthorne has been completed and that merchandise is now being installed for the grand opening on Thursday, Jan. 9.

Located just west of the San Diego Freeway and adjacent to the South Bay Shopping Center, Gold's Torrance store will be the sixth Southern California outlet for the 44-year-old home furnishings concern.

MARKSON SAID that the new store will contain 45,000 square feet of shopping area and will be the largest store of its kind in the entire South Bay area. It will carry a complete line of home furnishings, appliances, carpets and pianos. Markson has been in the home furnishings field for more than 12 years and with Gold's for the past three years. He was formerly assistant manager of the Gold's El Monte store.

HE SAID that he is moving his family, which includes his wife, Judith, and 18-month-old Susan, to the Torrance area where they will make their new home.

The store will be air conditioned throughout and equipped with a sprinkler system. Other Gold's stores are located in downtown Los Angeles, Panorama City, Lakewood, Anaheim and El Monte.
