University Extension Courses Set

Three special programs will mark the University of California Extension in the South Bay District during the spring semester.

"Religion Today," a lecture course which will explore the spiritual values "in an Ecumenical Era," will be held on 12 Tuesdays, beginning Feb. 18. The lectures will feature distinguished speakers from the arts and sciences, as well as representatives from various denominations and religions.

THE SERIES may be taken for credit and will meet at North High School each week from 7:30 to 10 p.m.

"The Negro in American Society," will be a thoughtful consideration of findings from social and psychological science concerning "the color line." Lecturers will include four members of UCLA's faculty, and James Farmer, National Director of the Congress of Racial Equality.

LECTURES WILL be held at South High School on five alternate Saturdays, beginning Feb. 22. Credit students also must attend seven class sessions, to meet on alternate Mondays, beginning Feb. 17. Classes meet from 7 to 10 p.m.

The final series, "The Arts on Film," will view movie-making as an art media. Robert Snyder will be the instructor. The arts include art and sculpture, painting, architecture, music, and dance. The lecture-film classes will begin Feb. 2 and meet from 7:30 to 10 p.m. on five consecutive Sundays in the El Camino College Little Theater.
