

Medic-Alert Week**


Five dollars could save your life!

**Formation Commission
Explained to Lomitians**

S. M. Schmidt, staff officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission, told members of the Lomita Civic League the agency will prohibit pockets of unincorporated areas in the county through its control of annexation and incorporation proceedings.
Schmidt told the organization that control of the commission would not rest with one or two men because of its makeup. He said two city councilmen, two members of the Board of Supervisors, and one member at large will compose the commission.
ALL ANNEXATION and incorporation proceedings initiated in the county in the future will have to be approved by the commission. The commission, organized under a new state law, is designed to keep such proceedings from leaving small areas of unincorporated land which would be deprived of essential services.
The league was told pending incorporation of the Lomita area does not have to be approved by the commission since proceedings were started before the law became effective.
SCHMIDT HAS served as assistant city manager in San Fernando and was appointed to his present position by Gordon Nesvig, clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
No proceedings are now in progress which will effect the proposed incorporation of Lomita, Schmidt said, as those annexation proceedings filed by Torrance have been dropped.

**Workshops in

Math Slated**

Miss Joan Baldwin and Henry Mansfield will address the junior college workshops in mathematics and science in April.
The workshops will be held in April at the Los Angeles City College and El Camino College.
Miss Baldwin, who will speak at the El Camino workshop in science, will chair the discussion in geology. The session will be held April 13.
Mansfield, a consultant speaker for the mathematics workshop, is assistant director of instruction in mathematics and engineering. The mathematics workshop will meet April 11 at Los Angeles City College.
