## GI Exemption Claim Forms Now in Mail

Veteran property exemption claim forms are in the mail to some 356,000 veterans who last year received the \$1,000 exemption, according to an announcement by Phil Watson, county assessor.

Watson warned that failure to answer all questions can result in denial of the claim. "Failure to fill in all blanks or to sign the form means an incomplete and unacceptable claim."

Any incomplete forms will be held in the main office. The veteran will be notified and he must appear in person within 10 days to complete the claim or he will forfeit the exemption.

Any veteran who does not receive an exemption claim form by Friday and whose service record is on file with the assessor may receive a form on request by contacting the Hall of Administration, 500 W. Temple St., MA 5-3611.

A veteran filing for the first time must appear in person at any assessor's office with a copy of his discharge and proof of property ownership. Deadline for returning the file-by-mail forms is 5 p.m., Monday, May 4.
