DR. RICHARD K. WELTE Gets Degree

Richard K. Welte, principal of Calle Mayor Elementary School, has been awarded his doctorate in education by the School of Education at the University of Southern California. Dr. Welte, a native of Salt Lake City, came to California in 1932. He attended elementary and high school in Los Angeles and Alhambra and received his bachelor's degree from the University of Southern California. He returned to USC to study for his master's degree, then began teaching in 1951 for the Los Angeles City School System. He came to Torrance in 1953 as a vice principal.


Spartans Named as Finalists

DR. WELTE served as vice principal at Crenshaw and Casimir before being named principal at Carr Elementary School. He was transferred to Calle Mayor School in 1961. He is currently president of the Torrance chapter of the California School Administrators Assn., a newly-formed group in the local district. Dr. Welte's doctoral dissertation was "Contractual Law and School Business Administration."
