Edison Co. Income Hits New Record

New highs in net income revenue were established in 1963 by the Southern California Edison Co., according to Harold Quinton, chairman of the board of the utility.

Quinton told a stockholders meeting recently gross earnings were \$1.78 per share on the 35,968,059 shares outstanding. The figures reflected a 7.2 per cent increase over the previous year.

The quarterly dividend on common stock was increased from 24 to 26 1/4 cents per share, the third increase in the past five years.

Gross revenue for the year advanced \$25.9 million, up 6.5 per cent over the previous year. Gross revenue was \$424.3 million, while net income was \$71,099,117.

Non-Resident Students Pay Tuition Fees

Non-resident students attending Los Angeles' seven junior colleges will face a tuition charge for the first time at summer sessions this year. The new regulation was approved last week by the city's Board of Education.

More than 1,300 full-time and 2,600 part-time students will be affected by the new rules. The fee rate of up to \$306 per year is established by the State Board of Education.

The new regulations will apply to minors whose parents or guardians do not live in California and to military personnel and their dependents. The board exempted all foreign students for one year.

Nine elementary schools in North Torrance will present their bands and orchestras in a combined concert tomorrow evening at the North High School gymnasium.


The program will begin at 8 o'clock. A combined band of 125 members, an orchestra of 150 members, and the North High Saxon band will be featured.
