

### Case Closed In Favor of Dairy Man

TORRANCE—Revoking of license on 182nd street, belonging to cense for operation of a dairy Peter Nuccio was bounced

around again last Friday night, when a majority vote from Councilmen present disbanded hearing on the case.

Donald Armstrong, representing Nuccio pointed out that the city had no right to forbid use of the controversial property for dairy purposes.

Armstrong based his opinion on: 1—The City Council and the Planning Commission have no jurisdiction of any kind over this property; 2—The Council in open meeting granted the permit to operate, and then the following day, in closed meeting, and without notifying even the defendant rescinded their action of the night before, which is not only illegal, but also unconstitutional.

Although, according to City Attorney C. Douglass Smith, Nuccio has no right to operate such a business in that district, permit or no permit; Council, with a 2 to 1 vote, closed the case.
