Lomitans Vote On County Water for New Tracts

LOMITA.—On August 1, Lomita residents will go to the polls to decide whether 42 out of 74 homes in a tract at Lomita boulevard and Western avenue will be admitted to the county water district.

Little opposition is expected to the proposal because the homebuilding firm has offered to stand the expense of water mains from existing lines to the tract.

Work on the second section of the tract will start in October, Lawson said. However, in the meantime, the builders, Lakewood Properties, Inc., of Long Beach, will move to Whittier to build 100 homes while awaiting a decision from the Los Angeles Board of Education and whether it wants the land for a high school site.

The board of education reportedly seeks 35 acres of the home building site for a new Narbonne High School. Negotiations opened but the board has been slow

about saying yes or no on the deal. Other houses in the tract will be in the city of Los Angeles and will receive water from the municipal department.

July 25 Deadline For Veterans to Get Benefits

The time of decision is "closer than you think" for World War II veterans who have not yet used any or all of their entitlement to the education and training benefits of the GI Bill of Rights, according to Miss Helen K. Dill, Director of the Veterans Service Center.

Approximately one out of three eligible veterans has never taken advantage of this type of benefit, probably because he had no need for it, Miss Dill said.

For most veterans, the final deadline for pursuing studies or on-the-job training under the GI Bill is July 25, 1951.



\$53,825 to Improve El Camino

Additional campus improvements and plans for permanent building construction occupied the time of the El Camino College Board of Trustees at its regular meeting last Tuesday, July 11, at the college. The board awarded contract in the amount of \$53,824.98 to G. G. Fisher Paving Company of South Gate for installation of curbs, gutters, sidewalks and private driveway paving along Crenshaw and Manhattan Beach Boulevard, including additional student parking areas.

This work is slated to commence within the next two weeks and to be completed by the beginning of the fall semester in September. Bids for this work were received from eleven contractors and ranged from the low bid to a high of \$69,324.9. Engineer's estimate for the work was \$65,000.
