

El Camino College To Get Lighting System

El Camino College is to be lit up, not like a church, but like a full-grown institution of higher learning as a result of action of the Board of Trustees meeting in regular session at the college last Tuesday.

Installation of a complete street lighting system along the college campus on Redondo Beach, Crenshaw, and Manhattan boulevards, with a similar type lighting for the interior area, was approved by the Board in awarding a contract for construction in the amount of \$41,432 to the C. D. Draucker Company of Los Angeles.

Work on the lighting contract is to be commenced immediately with completion scheduled by the beginning of the fall semester on September 11. Specifications call for the installation of the latest type Sodium Vapor lights on Marbelite standards.

In other actions, the Board approved the following items:

Elected the following new instructors for the fall semester:

John W. Houston as an instructor in Mathematics and English. Houston has a Master degree from the University of Montana and has done graduate work at Yale University and UCLA.

William E. Hartman, sociology and psychology. Hartman has a Doctors degree at USC.
