Dahlia Society Lists Many Medals, Trophies for Annual Flower Show

The Inglewood Dahlia Society this week listed the many awards to be presented to winners in the society's annual flower show, scheduled for this Saturday and Sunday in the Inglewood high school study hall.
 The show will open at 2 p.m. Saturday. Awards will be presented at 8 p.m. Saturday. Exhibitors will compete in five general divisions. The divisions, together with the awards, are:
 DIVISION 1 (Special Dahlia Section—Open to all): Largest and most perfect dahlia in the show—Sunset Mazahine Medal. Smallest and most perfect dahlia in the show—Orange County Dahlia Society Medal. Best individual dahlia in the show—Harry Marshall Perpetual Trophy. Most artistically arranged receptacle 12 or more blooms—De Bartola Trophy. Best container of foreign dahlias, one or more kinds—Rosette. Best California disseminated originations—Metzler Trophy. Best first year seedling—Inglewood Dahlia Society Trophy and Gold Certificate. Best third year seedling—American Dahlia Society Bronze Medal.
 DIVISION 2 CLASS A (Commercial Section 1 who sells more than \$100 worth): Sweepstakes—Inglewood Chamber of Commerce Trophy. Best General Display—Paul J. Howard Trophy. Most Artistic Display—Hawthorne Florist Trophy.
 DIVISION 2 CLASS B (One who grows more than 100 plants but sells less than \$100): Sweepstakes—James R. Robinson Trophy. Best General Display—Pansy M. Sill Trophy. Most Artistic Display—Large A&M Nippers.
 DIVISION 2 CLASS C (One who grows less than 100 plants, excluding pompons, miniatures and seedlings): Sweepstakes—Knot's Berry Farm Trophy. Best General Display—A&M Nippers. Most Artistic Display—A&M Nippers.
 DIVISION 2 CLASS D (For the novice who does not grow more than 50 plants): Sweepstakes—Yukon Dahlia Gardens Trophy.
 DIVISION 3, Begonia Section (For Amateurs): Best individual display—Star Fertilizer Company Trophy.
 DIVISION 4 (Garden Clubs) Best Display—Inglewood Lior Club Trophy.
 DIVISION 4 (Fuchsia Section for Amateurs): Best Individual Display—Inglewood Woman's Club Garden Section Trophy.
 DIVISION 5 CLASS A (For Amateurs): Flower Arrangement—Limit 3 per person. Best three arrangements—Laura Crandall Trophy.
 DIVISION 5 CLASS B (For the novice who has never won a ribbon—limit 3 per person): Best three arrangements—Roman Schmit Gift Award.
 DIVISION 5 MINIATURES—Best three arrangements—Trophy. Also other rosettes, blue and red ribbons, and special award and honorary mention ribbons.
