



 CAMP COOKE — Torrance soldiers called to active duty with the 40th Division this week were scattering to the four corners of the United States, temporarily at least.
 Of the several score of local men going into Federal service with the 578th Engineer Combat Battalion, several have already left this camp for special service schools elsewhere in the nation. Now at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, for a course in hospital procedure is Pfc. Jack Garland, a member of the battalion's Medical Detachment. Upon completion he will return to Camp Cooke.
 Going to radio school at Ft. Monmouth, N. J. is Sgt. Norman R. Stock, and Sgt. James G. Luter.
 Men from Company A, now attending special schools include Sgt. Peter Degman, Sgt. Hollis H. Rhine, and Sgt. Leroy B. Schwenk. The company was stationed at Torrance Ball Park prior to its induction. The three men are at Ft. Belvoir, Va., at construction foreman's school. Other Company A men at Ft. Belvoir for special training are Cpl. Reginald O'Donnell and Cpl. Keith A. Lewis.
