

### Two Local Servicemen Promoted

The promotion of two Hawthorne men, both currently serving with the U. S. Air Force's 452nd Bomb Wing (Light) in Japan, have been announced by Brig. General Luther W. Sweetser, Jr., commanding general of the wing.

Joseph W. Busby, whose wife, Dorothy, lives at 14003 Shoup avenue, was promoted to technical sergeant. He is a photographic laboratory technician with the wing. Prior to being recalled to active duty with the wing in August, he was a photo technician with Technicolor Corp. of Hollywood.

Sergeant Busby first entered military service in October, 1942. During World War II, he served 19 months in the European Theatre of Operations and flew 23 missions against the enemy. He is authorized to wear the European Theater ribbon with four battle stars, the Air Medal with two oak leaf clusters and the Belgian Fourragere.

Promoted to staff sergeant was Quentin Schlimmer, whose wife, Helen, lives at 480 West 180 street. Schlimmer is an armament specialist with one of the bomb squadrons of the 452nd Bomb Wing. Prior to being called back into service in August, the sergeant was an armament specialist for North American Aviation Co. at its Inglewood plant.

Sergeant Schlimmer's parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. R. Schlimmer, also lives in Hawthorne, at 345 East 134th street. Sergeant and Mrs. Schlimmer have a son, Michael, 2 1/2. The sergeant first entered military service in October, 1942, as a member of the ordnance department. He spent 22 months in Europe during World War II and holds the European Theater ribbon with five battle stars and the German occupation ribbon.
