**Vicar Attends Church Convention**

The Rev. Richard Ernest Lockwood, vicar, St. George's Mission, Hawthorne, is attending the 58th annual convention of the Episcopal diocese of Los Angeles. Johnson H. Flintham will accompany the vicar; George Bradford is alternate.

The diocese convened Tuesday and will meet through tomorrow. Appointment and election of the chairmen and members of various boards and committees who will handle the affairs of the eight county diocese under the Rt. Rev. Francis Eric Bloy, bishop of Los Angeles, will take place. Discussion and voting on the diocesan budget, progress reports from six convocations and 15 institutions through the southland, and planning of the year's program for the church is also on the agenda.

Attendance will include 175 rectors and vicars from almost as many parishes, missions and church institutions, and 350 lay delegates from Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, San Diego, San Bernardino, Orange, Riverside, Ventura and Imperial counties.
