

### Assignment For Torrance Men in Japan

YAMOTO, JAPAN—Torrance's Company A, 578th Engineers Combat Battalion, of the 40th Infantry Division, has headed for the field again to take over road and bridge repair projects near Sendai.

The men were recently sent to Japan after being stationed at Camp Cooke.

This is the Torrance unit's second such assignment, it having returned recently from a week of rebuilding narrow, rutted roads and bolstering rickety bridges for use by Army traffic. The battalion, which had two

companies located in Torrance before its induction into Federal service last September, is in the midst of a rigorous unit training program along with other elements of Southern California's 40th Infantry Division.

As a supplement to scheduled training and to accomplish vital engineer projects, the engineers have been sent out, one company at a time, to gain "on-the-job" experience.

Company A, which was stationed at Torrance Ball Park during its National Guard days, has been working near Funaoka,

a small town about 20 miles south of Sendai.

Headquarters and Service Company and the battalion's headquarters is still at Camp Matsuhashi. The headquarters was at Torrance Municipal Airport before its induction last fall.

"This may seem like getting the cart before the horse... we've been so busy rebuilding roads and repairing bridges that we've had little time for training in how to rebuild roads and repair bridges. But this actually is the best training we could be getting," was the way Lt. Col. Dallas I. Down, battalion commander, put it.
