Free Adult Education Classes Open Sept. 17

The free classes of the Torrance Adult School, open to all adults regardless of residence, will start on Monday, September 17 with a wide variety of courses in commercial, craft, creative, shop, and physical education.

Typing and shorthand classes will be handled by Mack Landar, whose aim is two-fold: typing for a job, and typing for personal use. Meta Betts, well-known professional cake decorator, will conduct her classes at both the High School and North Torrance Elementary School. Bessie Marsh, professional dressmaker, will conduct classes at the High School for both beginning and advanced students.

MACHINE SHOP
The machine shop classes are designed for both men and women. Those with no experience at all, and those who are advanced are equally welcome. Six different types of machines will equip students to handle a wide variety of jobs in aircraft and

other war plants, and shipyards. Clifford Inslee will run ceramics classes convenient to many men and women—at the High School, at Seaside, and at North Torrance.

Lampshade classes will be held in day and evening classes under Dorthea Le Menager, while Wanda Sexton will conduct painting classes at the High School. Students should go directly to class to register, and to be sure of being included, should attend the first session of the class.
