

Evangelistic Leader to Conduct Revival at First Baptist Church

Evangelist Smith has been a pastor for the past 25 years in San Diego, at the present time he is the acting president of the California Baptist Seminary in Covina. He is considered the dean of Baptist preachers.

Outstanding talent such as Steady Nelson, trumpeter formerly with Horace Heidt and Woody Herman, Bill Carl, Bass, formerly with N.B.C. and Toscani, Tim Spencer of the Sons of the Pioneers will be heard nightly except Saturday. The services will start at 7:30 p.m. each evening with Rev. J. Russell Killman leading the music.
