Sermons on Prayer To Be Scheduled

According to Rev. Miller, a promotion committee has been set up and plans are going forward for the local campaign. A visiting minister from some church will assist in the services.

The second period of the "Evangelistic Advance" will involve churches outside of the 50 mile radius of Los Angeles, with the ministers of the Los Angeles area serving as leaders.
