

Rocha Given Permit

Petition of Manuel L. Rocha for a variance and conditional permit to build an addition to an existing cow barn, increasing it from a thirty cow capacity to a forty-five cow capacity was approved by both the Planning Commission and City Council, this week.

Location of Rocha's addition will be at 17851 Arlington Ave., between 174th St. and 182nd Streets. It is situated in an A-1 limited agricultural zone.

The request for the addition was necessary, due to an order by the Approval Milk Inspection Service of the Los Angeles County Health Department, whereby a more adequate job of Grade A milk production can be maintained, and does not provide for any expansion in the dairy proper.

This approval was given with the understanding that the number of milk cows on the premises at any one time will not exceed 200, nor will the total number of cattle at any one time exceed 250.

Building Need Survey Begins

At the request of El Camino college officials, the California State Department of Education's division of Vocational Education has been assisting in a survey of the building needs of the trade and industrial programs at the college.

John Mills, assistant director of instruction in charge of business and vocational fields at El Camino stated this is "the most scientific study ever made by El Camino of a phase of its program. It is a study long needed and will continue with committees composed of advisors from local trade and industry to assist in the evaluation."


