The first American division to enter the fighting in Korea, the 24th has played a major role in UN offensives north and south of the 38th parallel.

Private Moore's wife, Ruth E., is living in Beryl, Utah.

Moore received his basic training at Camp Roberts, Calif.

After a leave at home he was on his way to the Far East. He arrived in Korea on August 1, 1951, and was assigned to the fighting front.

Private Moore has been awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge and the Korean Service Ribbon with one campaign star.

Before entering the army he was employed as a truck driver.
