Police Nab 8 After Brutal Beating; Avert Gang War

Answering a complaint of a brutal attack in front of 2114 W. 182nd St., Torrance Police quickly halted a threatened gang fight between Torrance and Gardena youths last Friday night and arrested eight juveniles for possession of deadly weapons.

Officers Eugene Erbetta and A. W. Winkler answering the call found one Joe Acosta brutally beaten and his 1938 Chrysler smashed with crowbars, stones, bottles and clubs.

Officers said that Acosta was trailed from 178th street and Western avenue to the 182nd street address where three carloads of young hoodlums forced him off the road.

Later Erbetta and Winkler spied two carloads of youths at 182nd and Prairie avenue, and after finding several weapons including a gun, booked all eight on penal code violations.

City Judge Otto B. Willett sentenced them to pay a \$10 fine or spend 30 days in jail, and suspended another 30-day jail stay, and placed them on summary probation for six months.

Arrested were Joaquin Vega, Angel Acosta, Luis Acosta, Joe Rodriguez, Adolfo Grajeda, Rudy Guzman, Hector Duarte and Dave Molinar, records show.
