

Local Milk Prices Low on U. S. Scale

This is the month to get acquainted with your milkman, all the milk products, and some very important facts about the dairy industry in California.

The California Dairy Industry Advisory Board and the U. S. Bureau of Agricultural Statistics

have compiled the following list of interesting and important facts about the dairy business.

1. California's great dairy industry is vital to the health and wealth of all who live within the borders of the State. As an economic asset it's second only to petroleum.

2. It employs more than 300,000 persons with a payroll exceeding 200 millions, most of which is spent in their local communities. It pays upwards of 10 million an-

nually in state and local taxes alone.

3. California ranks first among all the states in the production of milk per cow. Our cows produce about 40 per cent more than the national average.

4. For the past five years Los Angeles County has led all other counties in the United States in total production from its dairy farms.

5. California farmers pay 38 per cent higher wages than the

national average.

6. In 1941 an average week's wages bought 275 quarts of milk. A week's wages now buys 331 quarts . . . 56 quarts more!

7. The retail price of milk in Los Angeles and San Francisco is more than ONE-HALF CENT LOWER per quart than the average of America's 25 largest cities.


