**Grant Bid for Courthouse Construction**

A resolution from the City of Torrance offering use of its City Hall Court Room facilities at \$1 per year was received and filed by the Los

Angeles County Board of Supervisors at their meeting Tuesday.

Supervisor Ray Darby urged its acceptance for use until already needed additions to the new South Bay Cities Court House in Redondo Beach could be completed.

The Board awarded a contract to Barienbrack and Kleigman for the construction of the addition.

The additions amounting to \$58,900 had been approved for some time, according to Darby, but had not been included in the existing structure last year because of lack of funds.
