

### Flies Can Be Eliminated

Want to keep flies out of your home? Then follow this advice from Dr. George M. Uhl, city health officer:

Empty garbage cans at least twice a week. Scrub them thoroughly after each emptying to remove all sludge. Be sure that no particles of food are left around the garbage can area.

Bury animal droppings before flies lay their eggs on them. These are the greatest attractors of flies. A good place to bury them is in flower beds.

Keep grass and other yard clippings in a metal container until they are hauled away or burned. Decaying clippings are excellent fly-breeding materials.

Clean chicken manure from under pens at least weekly, and lime them. Once dry, this can be used as fertilizer without danger of attracting flies.

Rinse thoroughly all food cans after opening them and before throwing them away. Even small food particles left in cans will attract flies.

Keep your home well screened. Keep food well covered.

## Council OKs Maps for Huge Tract in Southwest Section

A \$15,000,000 housing development in the southwest section of Torrance is being considered by the City Planning Commission.

All of the 1309 Housing units would be three-bedroom types, estimated to cost about \$12,000 a piece, Earle A. Lloyd, planning consultant reported.

The development will be bounded by WALTERIA, Pacific Coast Hwy., the South Torrance boundary and the Hollywood Riviera district.

Tentative maps filed with the commission by Ellinwood Corp., owner of the land, show the subdivision will extend part way up the north slope of the Palos Verdes hills.

If approved the tract will be the largest ever constructed in the area, and work is expected to begin early next year.

Meanwhile, the City Council Tuesday night OKed tract maps for a proposed subdivision of 172 two and three-bedroom homes to be constructed east of Crenshaw Blvd. and south of Pacific Coast Hwy.

Planned by the January Co. of Long Beach, the tract will be similar to the tract west of Crenshaw


