Motorists Warned Flashing Lights On School Bus Mean Full Stop

With the annual back-to-school trek in high gear, Capt. O. H. Ellis, commander of the local squad of the California Highway Patrol, today said officers were ready to cite drivers who ignore the flashing red lights on school buses.
