

### Workers on Job Again At Douglas

More than 400 striking workers at the Torrance Douglas Aircraft plant were back on the job Monday morning, after union leaders halted the strike.

The back-to-work order was termed a "recess" in the strike by union officials.


They said it will last while negotiations to settle the wage dispute are carried on in Washington, under the auspices of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service.

At the local plant, 800 persons actually returned to the job: 400 strikers, and 400 fellow employees who did not cross the two-week-old picket line thrown up by the International Association of Machinists, AF of L.
