liminary trial hearings. Under present circumstances a Torrance resident will have to travel five or six miles into Redondo Beach to pay a \$2 traffic fine. This, it is felt, is hardly the kind of service taxpayers should be receiving from their courts.

90,000 Persons Per Judge
Judge Shidler stated that, to his knowledge, there is no other judicial district in which there are 90,000 persons to each judge. He pointed out that in Los Angeles there are 50,000 persons per judge, and in Burbank this figure drops to 40,000 for each magistrate.

Yet, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors refuses to make any effort to obtain another judge for the South Bay Court.

Last year the California Senate Interim Judiciary Committee recommended that a third office be created. Voters of this area were led to believe, by the Board of Supervisors, that this would be done.

However, the Board later changed its stand, and only two judge-ships were established.

Judge Higgins cited the rule-of-thumb used in the past that holds that there shall be a judge for every 49,000 persons in a given area. This precedent, he claims, automatically entitles the Bay area to another judge.

After January 1st, there will be eight separate law enforcement bodies feeding cases into the South Bay Court. There are two judges, and only one courtroom to handle all cases from the six municipal police departments, the California Highway Patrol, and the County Sheriff's offices.
