Councilman Dral brought up the question of what would happen if Carpenter didn't take the exam. Would he asked the City Attorney, Jim Hall, this city have two recreation directors for nearly six months?

Hall stated that the council would have to name a director from the civil service eligible list, probably early in January, and that at that time, Carpenter's job would have to be terminated if Carpenter didn't take the exam and receive the council's appointment.

Meanwhile, members of the recreation commission, appointed in October by Mayor Mervin Schwab, denied that they were about to "toss in the sponge." Several members stated that the city is still faced with a critical problem of how to administer a recreation program, and that they would continue to do their best no matter who quits what.

A year-long search ended this week in fruition when a North Torrance housewife was united with her father, who for 26 years, did not even know of her existence.

The search resulted from a strange family mixup that began in Marissa, Ill., in 1926 when a baby girl was adopted by friends of her mother a few days after her birth.

The end of the search came two months ago when Russell Welsh, 48-year-old construction worker, received a letter at his Danville, Ky., home.

Welsh expressed delighted surprise on Sunday when he met for the first time his 26-year-old daughter, Mrs. Edward Clark of 3224 West 185th st., and discovered that he had three young grandchildren.

Welsh disclosed that he had separated from his wife eight months before his daughter was born.

On Sunday he learned of Mrs. Clark's determination to find her father. Her mother still resides in Illinois.

Letter Insured

Through relatives in Illinois, Mrs. Clark traced the 26-year-old trail, until October when one of her many letters drew an answer from her father.

Now that he is in California, Welsh plans to remain here, to
