

Head-on Collision Leaves Four Dead; One Injured

A spectacular head-on collision here claimed the lives of four persons and left another critically injured New Year's day. The accident occurred on Vermont Ave. near Carson St.

The dead included two brothers and the wife of one of them. The other wife was critically injured. Killed were Lorne W. Robinson, 27, Raymond R. Robinson, 25, and Mrs. Lillian Robinson, all of Los Angeles, and Peggy Louise McKee of North Redondo.

Mrs. Evelyn Robinson, wife of one of the dead brothers, is in critical condition at Harbor General Hospital with skull and facial fractures. The accident scene is not far from the spot where a Keystone woman was killed and nine others injured in a collision between an ambulance and an automobile less than a month ago.


