**DOES THE JOB**—And a man-size job it is to dispose of all the garbage and paper waste, wet and dry, of a thriving restaurant. But the commercial-type Calcinator, complete garbage disposal, is doing just that job for John C. Bickham, co-owner of Torrance's Westerner Drive-In Restaurant. Bickham reports that the Calcinator has eliminated the need for waste containers and fly-breeding garbage cans at the drive-in.

**Solves Waste Problem**

**Westerner Drive-in Uses Sanitary, New Calcinator**

The test of a product is the satisfaction of the user. The unqualified satisfaction of one user of the new Calcinator, completely automatic garbage and trash disposal, was reported this week.

John C. Bickham, co-owner of Torrance's Westerner Drive-in restaurant, declared today that the Calcinator has proved to be the answer to the all-important problem of disposing of large quantities of garbage and waste of all types in his restaurant.

"The top aim of the Westerner," Bickham said, "is to give top quality and completely sanitary service. To this end we have used the newest, most efficient garbage disposal device, the new Calcinator."

"Because the Calcinator eliminates all garbage and trash, wet or dry, we have no need for garbage cans or trash barrels. The net result is that we have no flies in or near our kitchen to create unsanitary conditions," he added.

**Heavy Use Told**

At least 250 pounds of garbage, 500 pounds of waste paper, and 50 pounds of bones are dumped into the commercial-type Calcinator at the local restaurant each week day. This load is nearly doubled over the week-end, Bick-

ham reported. The unit is in continuous operation.

Bones, egg shells, and coffee grounds are among the many types of waste materials that are deposited into the Calcinator each day at the Westerner. Because the remarkable new device disposes of both wet and dry garbage and waste, no time is spent separating the waste materials. Each car-hop as she returns trays from cars, simply opens the Calcinator and dumps all waste matter into the "always-cool unit," Bickham said.

**Matter Destroyed**

The Calcinator effectively destroys all food matter and other materials, except metal and glass, by the process of first dehydrating, then burning them completely.

Current of air heated by a tiny gas flame draw all moisture from the waste and garbage. The refuse then burns, leaving only a small amount of fine white ash.


The unit will be at the Civic Auditorium from 3 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. to receive blood donations.
