**14 Torrance Bus Drivers Get Safety Record Pins**

**Free Lectures on Child Growth at Seaside School**

Mrs. Law is well qualified to speak on this topic because of her varied background in human relations. She is a member of the Compton Counseling Service and church counselor at the First Methodist Church, Redondo Beach.
