Drale and Victor E. Benstead, have consistently pressed for the annexation, but have been the sole proponents of the move in the City Council.

Hall also said that at one time the Council was enthusiastic about annexing the park, and even had his office draw a resolution to the effect. However, they lost their enthusiasm apparently due to the pressure of another Torrance paper and its publisher—and Torrance has lost Alondra park forever just like the community has lost many other opportunities for progress due to this source of opposition.
