- 2 Be sure the string is perfectly dry.
- 3 Never use wire, tinseel or metallic string.
- 4 If your kite catches in a power line, let go immediately. Don't pull! Phone the company owning the line and a lineman will get your kite for you.

PLANS FOR NEW ARLINGTON AVE. NEAR COMPLETION

The city engineering department expects to have final cost estimates on the proposed extension of Arlington Ave. ready within a week or ten days, department officials disclosed this week.

Maps and profile drawings of the new avenue have been completed and are ready for presentation to the City Council.

Acting on a recommendation by Councilman Nick Draie, the city is moving forward with plans for the break-through of the street, which will provide a north-south arterial running through the downtown business section.

Stating that a tremendous revenue is being lost to this city and to the merchants because no major street or avenue runs through central Torrance, Draie has urged that Arlington ave. be opened up and improved.

Arlington ave. now ends at 190th st., and is resumed at 203rd st. to where it joins Cabrillo ave.

Merchants and business leaders here who have been queried on the subject have wholeheartedly endorsed the plan.
