**New Minneapolis-Honeywell Factory to Employ 2,000**

A veritable armada of earth-moving machinery filled, graded and leveled the site of the new Minneapolis-Honeywell factory last week, accomplishing in two days what ordinarily would take a month.

Scores of bulldozers, carry-alls and truck cranes assembled on the 16-acre tract at 174th st. and Western ave., Gardena, and swiftly prepared the site for construction of the huge factory.

**Expansion**

The plant is being built as part of an expansion program by Minneapolis-Honeywell Regulator Company. The new building will enable the firm to expand production of automatic controls for water heaters, floor furnaces, wall heaters and central heating plans, which is now being carried out at a smaller plant in Los Angeles, according to John E. Haines, vice-president of Honeywell.

**June Deadline**

The first unit of the new plant, a machine shop, is expected to be completed by June, according to Architect Kenneth H. Neptune. Other sections will be erected in progressive stages. The factory will be of steel frame, reinforced concrete construction and functional design. It will have a steel roof deck with a sawtooth pattern. Two huge parking lots will be provided for employees and customers.

Honeywell already has more than 800 employees in California working in the present plant in Los Angeles and in various sales offices.
