

Central Kitchen Considered for Local Schools

The possibility of establishing a central kitchen to prepare hot lunches for all schools within the district was discussed by the board of education at their regular meeting Tuesday night.

At present, some schools in the district do not have kitchen facilities. A central kitchen would save the necessity of adding this facility to the schools, it was pointed out.

In addition, economy could be effected in preparation, buying of foodstuffs, and kitchen personnel.

On the other hand, board members said, problems of transporting the hot food to the various schools would arise.

A similar plan has been used successfully in Long Beach, it was disclosed. Board members indicated an experimental central kitchen to serve several elementary schools may be tried in the near future.

What's the difference between an accountant and an auditor? T. C. Messerve, U. S. Civil Service Secretary at the Torrance Post Office, says, "In the simplest terms, an accountant makes up accounts, and an auditor analyzes them."

Whatever the difference, he says, there are openings for accountants and auditors in Federal agencies in California, Nevada and Arizona, in essential work involving business accounting and cost accounting.

Starting salaries range from \$4,205 to \$8,360 a year. There is no maximum age limit. The minimum grade requires at least 3 1/2 years of general experience. Higher grades require general and specialized experience.

Super Press Developed by Local Firm

Development and successful use of an advanced-type, high-production stretch-form press, designed for quick and accurate forming of aluminum alloy extrusions and sheets, was announced recently by Longren Aircraft Co. of Torrance. The new machine occupies only 25 per cent of the floor area, and costs only 20 per cent as much as other stretch-forming machines.

Speeds Production
The machine was developed to speed up production and lower costs. Its operations include pre-forming, wrapping, skin pressing, stretch-leveling, bending, forming, and stretch pressing of a wide variety of parts to double curvature, Longren engineers reveal.

Many advantages are claimed for the Peterson press compared with other stretch-presses: lower cost, simpler construction, simpler installation, less floor space, greater flexibility of operation, and fewer operating personnel. The machine requires as little as two minutes to load, form, and unload, after setup is made.

No Hand Finishing
Material to be formed in the Peterson press is laid over the forming die and gripped by chucks. Parts formed without springback and no hand finishing is required.

Because of the constant demand the company has decided to manufacture a limited number of these presses for resale, a spokesman disclosed.


