### Spring Clean-up Of Rural Mail Boxes Underway

Spring is traditionally a time for general cleaning-up, and even the federal government recognizes that fact. The post office department of the government has set aside a week in April for "Rural Mailbox Improvement."

Mrs. Clara Conner, Torrance postmaster, this week asked all rural post box owners to get out the hammer and nails and paint brush and bring their boxes up to snuff.

"A rural mailbox can be an asset to any home, and a good, strong box is absolutely necessary to protect the mail," she said. The postmaster recommends that rickety supports and rusty mailboxes be replaced now. The boxes can be made to look very attractive, she points out, by planting a few flowers around the base of the post.

She urged the homeowners to paint their name clearly on the side of the box facing the approaching mail car. If several boxes are grouped together, she asked that the names be painted on the door of the box.

The standard metal rural-mailbox, approved by the post office department, will facilitate delivery of mail and protect it against the elements, she added.

### Industries May Hire Teachers

Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent of schools, told the Board of Education Tuesday of a plan he is considering which would involve contacting local industries to ask if they would hire local teachers during the summer months.

Such a set-up, said Dr. Hull, would establish good public relations, provide labor for the industries, give teachers an understanding of the local area and its life, and enable them to earn some additional money. The program would be repeated every summer, he stated.
