

### Tot Shop Victim Of Till-Tapping; Couple Sought

Not until 9 p.m. did Mrs. Anita Mahon of Neta's Tot 'N Teens, 1272 Sartori st., discover that \$380 were missing from a separate drawer under the counter used for cashing checks, police files reveal.

The woman reported having seen two colored people who had come into the store Friday night between six and seven p.m. They had gone to the rear but had left as the clerk approached, saying that they wanted to check on the right size.

As no checks had been cashed till 9 p.m., the fact that money was missing was not discovered till then.

The colored couple under suspicion was described as follows: the woman very striking and outstanding, very heavy rouged lips, about 25 to 30 years old, 5' 6", slender build, the man very light complected, about 40 to 45 years old, very heavy set and chunky, it was reported.

### Halt Hearing In Robbery, Embezzling

The arraignment of William McNally, the ex-convict implicated in the recent \$30,000 robbery of the manager of an employees' credit union, was postponed once more, this time till next Wednesday at 10:30. His attorney had not yet studied the case sufficiently, it was declared by Det. Capt. Ernie Ashton of the Torrance police department.

In the meantime Alden, the victim of the robbery, appeared for sentencing in the Los Angeles Superior Court on charges of embezzlement Tuesday. Sentence was delayed, however, because Alden was not represented by an attorney and the law does not permit sentencing under those conditions, it was reported.

Alden will appear for sentencing today. He has been given a public defendant.

Donald S. Madlung, 24, one other suspect in the robbery, is being held presently in Washington by the FBI. Extradition papers are being processed permitting Ashton to pick up Madlung.

Madlung had his former residence at 1646 Cabrillo ave. A third member of the group, Paul Franks, 31, of 1627 W. 203rd st., is still being sought.
