

### Seven Local Students with Concert Band

Seven of the 85 student band members which will participate in the All Southern California High School Band Concert are Torrance high school students, according to Patrick McNaughton, conductor and music instructor of Torrance high school.

The concert is to be held at the El Camino college campus center, Saturday, May 9, from 7 to 10 p.m.

Torrance students include: Harold Holmes, assistant concert master, clarinet; Jack Johnston, clarinet; Paul Rowe, baritone saxophone; Dan Buckley, alto saxophone; Jim Thompson, trombone; John Meyers, tuba; Ted Chlanda, bassoon; Rudy Bowen, no longer with the band but serving in the navy.

Members of the band, including the seven Torrance youths, were chosen by elimination from among 200 applicants from 27 high schools as far north as Merced and as far south as San Diego, McNaughton stated.

Manager for the concert will be George Reist of the Torrance high school teaching staff.
