Organization for the Fall Community Chest campaign got off to a fine start last Friday when William C. Bullock, Harbor Area chairman, met with members of Chest agencies Participation Committee in the Torrance Young Women's Association on Carson Street.

Jack N. Dabbs, chairman of the highly successful Red Feather appeal in Torrance, was named as area vice-chairman for Torrance and Lomita. Bullock, who was area vice-chairman in the 1952 campaign, is a long-time San Pedro resident, is active in many community projects and is manager of Southern Counties Gas Company.
Particular work of the Agency Participation Committee, composed of volunteer heads and executive directors of Chest agencies located in the Harbor area, will be to secure volunteer campaign workers from their various organizations.
