

# LONGREN TO SELL PRESSES Plans Ready For Church Construction

Machinery and equipment that has aided Longren Aircraft Co., Torrance, to almost double its production of aircraft parts will be made available for sale for the first time to the open market.

This was announced by Hampden Wentworth, managing director of Longren Aircraft Co. who stated that the aircraft manufacturing firm has entered the special machinery manufacturing field by forming a Machine Building Division to manufacture and market their many specialized metal forming presses and equipment.

To date, this equipment has been developed for their own use. Now, for the first time, Longren will make available to aircraft manufacturers and industrial firms the noted Longren-designed Stretch-Forming Presses, Curved-Jaws for stretch-forming presses, forming twistlers and hand-forming contour fixtures.

Wentworth stated that additional machinery and equipment enabling more economical forming of metal are in development or production stages.
