 If the City Council will accept the Planning Commission's recommendation and thus ignore the attorney's petition, it is possible that the matter will be taken to the superior court.
 According to the Subdivision Map Act of the State of California, a party has the right to test the reasonableness of the action of the council, it was stated.
 In subdivision matters a party has the right of review, and such matters take procedure over all cases other than criminal or probate.
 The case could be heard within 60 days after the complaint is filed.
