





400 Phones
Born in Wisconsin, Miss Faulkner started her telephone career as an operator with Pacific Telephone in Centralia, Washington, 33 years ago. She transferred to the Torrance office, then located on Cabrillo street, in 1924. At that time there were only 400 Torrance telephones, and she and six other operators knew most of the numbers from memory.

The four positions of switchboard in 1924 grew to 25 and the operators totaled 75 by the time the cutover to dial was made here last summer. Both Lomita and Torrance "O" operator calls are now handled from the Sartori avenue office by a staff of 35 operators.
