Kids Shouldn't Solicit Funds, P-TA Policy

The door-to-door soliciting of funds for telethons by school children is not in accordance with the policies of Tenth District P-TA, according to Mrs. Ralph E. Lewis, president of the district. In a letter to all local presidents, Mrs. Lewis stated that the P-TA is not against these fine organizations that do so much for the citizens of our community, but it is contrary to Parent-Teacher policy to use children to collect funds.

The parents should refuse to allow the child to participate in such soliciting ventures.
