### City 'Y' Representatives Attend International Eve

Members of the Torrance YWCA attended the International Evening at the San Pedro YW when Mrs. Gilbert Myers in celebration of World Fellowship Week.

Istanbul Mrs. Myers told the group of the work being carried on by the World's YWCA in the Middle East. Whisking the group on a magic carpet, so to speak, they first visited the YW in Istanbul where it is called the American Service Center as Turkey is a Moham- endan country and would not permit the word Christian in the title. In these centers one of which was just opened on October 16, girls are trained to be secretaries. The American Service Center is the only place in Istanbul where this training is offered. Here classes are given in Turkish, French, and English to prepare the girl for the particular office in which she will work. Every girl who is trained is placed.

This YW also operates a camp and offers cooking and conversational language groups as well as operating a center for the undernourished. One of the centers in the area operates a hostel with several rooms for transients.

Beirut In Beirut the YW maintains vocational schools for over 300 girls. This is the only place in Beirut where girls can live away from home. The American secretary, Dorthea McDowell asked Mrs. Myers to tell the Americans how much they appreciate the help which comes through the World Fellowship fund, Mrs. Myers stated, Preceding Mrs. Myers' talk, Mrs. Harry Nishimoto sang an opening devotional, The Twenty-Third Psalm by Malotte.

Mrs. Louis Ladra, chairman of the Harbor Area World Fellowship committee welcomed the group and explained the purpose of World Fellowship Week.

To set the tone of the meet- ing, Mrs. Nishimoto accom- panied by Mrs. Robert Cofield sang, "Kashmiri Song" by Woodforde-Finden and "Song of India" by Rimski Korsakoff. Following the program tea and cookies from many lands were served in the lounge. Dur- ing the evening gifts from India were sold to add to the World Fellowship Fund.
