Seeking a \$14,899 goal, the 500 volunteers on Torrance's Community Chest team have solicited \$15,938 for a percentage figure of 106.97 per cent. This percentage figure was good enough so they could win the quota-buster trophy donated by Sam Levy which goes to the city attaining the highest percentage.

Other award winners from Torrance were city chairman, Tommy Thompson; residential division chairman, Patty Rudnick, and section chairman, Mrs. Gene Sleeth.

Thompson and Rudnick received their awards for outstanding service to the Community Chest and Mrs. Sleeth received her award for the first section to go over the top in the Harbor area.

There were four possible awards to win and Torrance gained all four.

The Harbor area has reached 90 per cent of its total. Seeking an \$82,059, the area has come up with \$47,833 to date. In accepting the Sam Levy Trophy presented by Sam Levy personally, Tommy Thompson said that the people of Torrance should be congratulated for the wonderful response that they gave to this Community Chest venture and also for the outstanding work or the tireless work of the over 700 volunteers.
