Dr. Sellstrom Addresses Group

Dr. Maureen Sellstrom, well-known authority on family relationships, and a most popular lecturer and author, spoke to the Torrance Parent Education class recently.

The speaker said most American parents want their children to learn to live with habits that will make them loved by their fellow beings and to live happily in this democratic country.

Therefore, in over-emphasizing obedience and expecting instant compliance a parent denies his child a sense of judgment. For example, how can a child resist a kidnaper if he has always been taught to obey an adult command.

Dr. Sellstrom went on to say that it is vitally important that a child be ready both physically and mentally to learn whatever is to be taught, also to give him time to practice.

She indicated that when punishment was corporal it must not be greater than the amount of damage committed by the child. However, she felt that corporal punishment should never be administered for failure in toilet training, especially when a child has acted in a negative fashion because of a feeling of lack of love or when he is lonely.

"Nagging," claims Dr. Sellstrom, "should be substituted with constructive propaganda. Sarcasm increases the likelihood of problems with adults later in life because a pre-school child does not understand it. Young children are very literal about words."

Concluding her discussion she remarked about the importance of the following items: Have the attention of the child or don't explain; disagreement between parents should be discussed away from the child; understand the age and individual needs and even change the rule when necessary and of course respect the child's property rights.
