Margarine Adds Flavor, Nutriment

Margarine adds flavor and nutriment to simple meals prepared quickly by the busy housewife. Recipes follow:

WEEK-END CASSEROLE

- 2 tablespoons Nucoa margarine
- 3 tablespoons flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 3 cups cooked vegetables
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1/4 cup liquid from vegetables, or water.
- 1/4 cup milk
- 3 tablespoons margarine crumbs
- Grated cheese, if desired

Almost any vegetable may be used singly or in combination. Place margarine, flour, salt and pepper in saucepan. Blend together and cook, but do not brown. Stir in vegetable liquids, and boil 2 or 3 minutes. Stir in milk. Place vegetables in casserole; add sauce. Sprinkle margarine crumbs and cheese on top. Place in moderate oven (325 degrees to 375 degrees Fahrenheit) until top is browned.

CHOP DISH

- 1 can luncheon meat
- 1/2 cup crushed pineapple or other fruit
- 1/2 cup Nucoa margarine
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 2 tomatoes
- 6-8 carrots
- 1-2 cups canned or frozen lima beans

Set the oven control at a moderate position (325 degrees to 375 degrees Fahrenheit) and start it heating. Prepare a baking dish by arranging the fruit, 2 tablespoons margarine, and 2 tablespoons sugar in the bottom. Place the canned luncheon loaf in the pan. Place in the oven. Prepare the carrots and beans. They may be cooked in the oven with the meat or on the surface. Add enough water to cover bottom of pan; add salt, and cook until tender. Season with margarine. Arrange the hot meat loaf and vegetables on a chop dish.
