Christmas Seal Drive Fails Goal

Despite a flood of contributions from Torrance and Los Angeles County families, the 1953 Christmas Seal drive missed by over \$158,000 its goal of \$650,000 by Christmas Day.

Said Dr. David T. Proctor, president of the county TB association, as he reported that only 75 per cent of the goal had been reached. "Now that the Christmas rush is over, many of us who have put aside our Christmas Seal letter will have time to answer it."

"Christmas Seals are actually gifts of health to family and community," he added. "We hope to make the goal by the end of the year. If we do not raise the minimum fund of \$650,000, TB control programs which have protected us all in the past, will suffer seriously next year."

Dr. Proctor explained in conclusion that the Los Angeles County Tuberculosis and Health Association will continue to accept contributions mailed to Christmas Seal Fund, Box 5735, Metropolitan Station, Los Angeles 55.

Evicted Woman Steals Goods
