SCHOOL BOND ABSENTEE VOTERS

A registered voter expecting to be absent from his election precinct on School Bond Election day, March 9, 1954, may procure his ballot by:

1. Making his own application, signed in his own handwriting, and addressing it to the Registrar of Voters, 808 North Spring street, Los Angeles 12, California. Application forms for this purpose may be obtained from the Board of Education office, 2335 Plaza del Amo, Torrance.
2. The request for an absent

voter's ballot must contain reason for absence from the polls on election day; voter's name and home address, as well as the address to which he wishes the ballot sent, and signature must be identical with that appearing on the original affidavit of registration.

3. Application for absent voter's ballot cannot be accepted by the Registrar of Voters more than twenty nor less than five days prior to election day.
